We advise the investors to not fall prey to these fake link and stay vigilant of such scams.

Investors may also note that neither PGIM India Mutual Fund or PGIM India Asset Management Private Limited, has website by any name other than <https://www.pgimindiamf.com> nor does it have group/s on any social media channels like Telegram or Whatsaspp, which in anyway promote investment advise or ask for investments from people. The general public should take note as anyone who engages with the said fake groups / phishing websites, or any other platform and material promoted by the impostors does so at their own risk.
